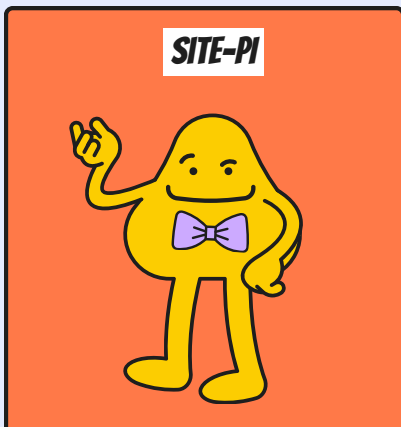
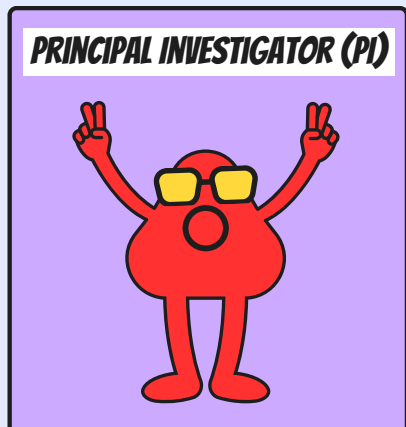




## ECOS - ATTENTION INVESTIGATORS!!



To successfully submit a **new study application or study amendment** on ECOS, **PI, Site-PI and Co-I(s)** listed in **Section B2** of the IRB application form will need to ensure the following are completed:

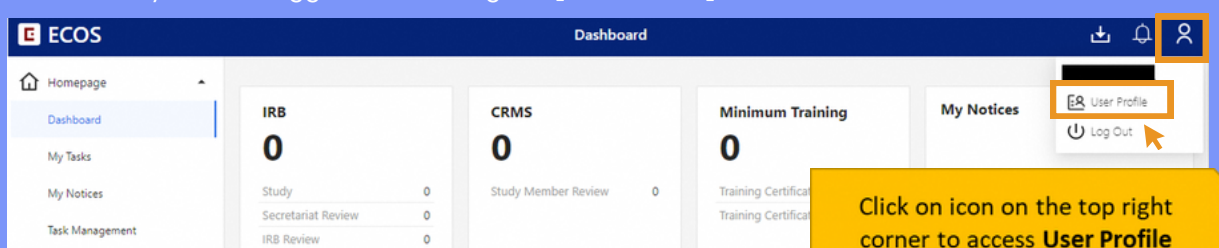
- 1) User Profile
- 2) Minimum Training
- 3) FCOI Declarations

### - Step by Step Guide -

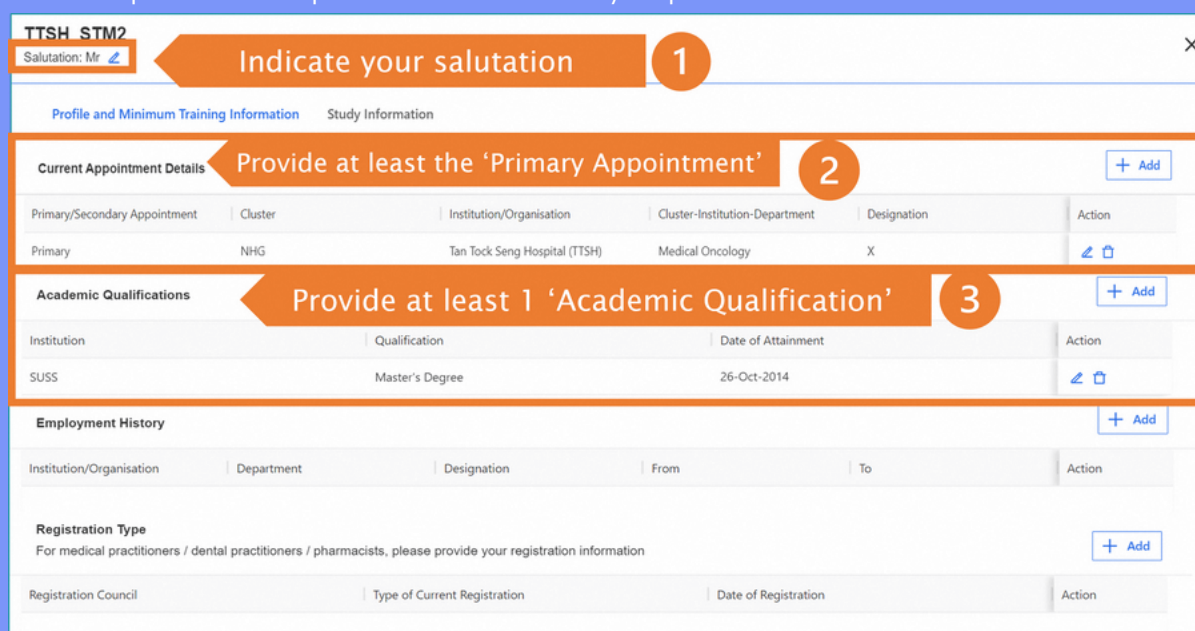

#### Set Up Your User Profile

- Once you have logged into ECOS, go to [User Profile]



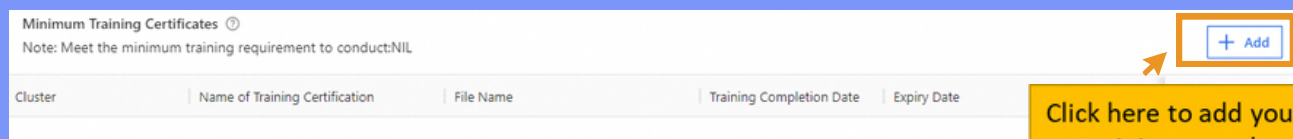
- Complete all the required information under your profile



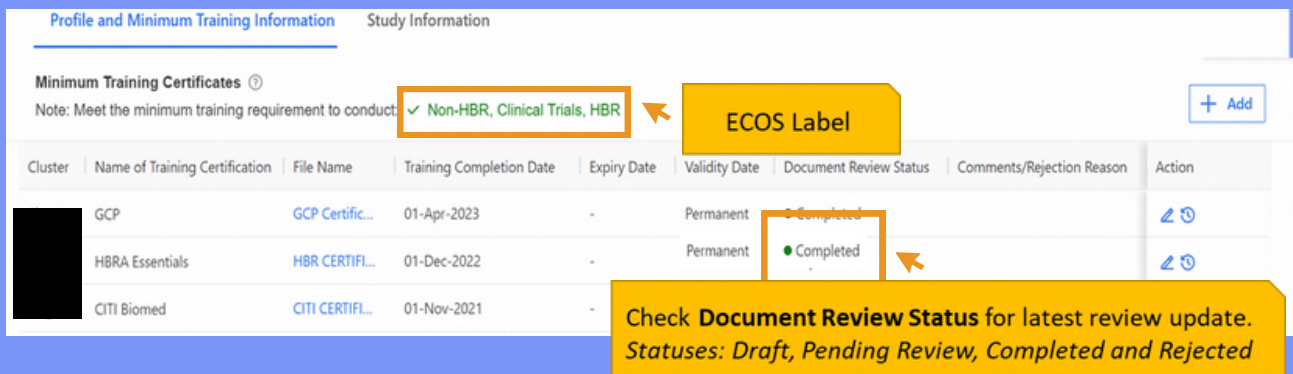

#### Submit Your Minimum Training Certificates For Verification

- Under [User Profile], scroll to the [Minimum Training Certificates] section
- Submit your Minimum Training Certificates to the **ECOS Minimum Training Secretariat** for verification



- When all relevant minimum training certificates have been successfully verified, you will receive the corresponding ECOS label on your profile



### What Is an ECOS Label?

PI, Site PI and Co-Investigators will need the relevant “labels” in order to submit the corresponding type of study selected in Section D of the IRB Application Form

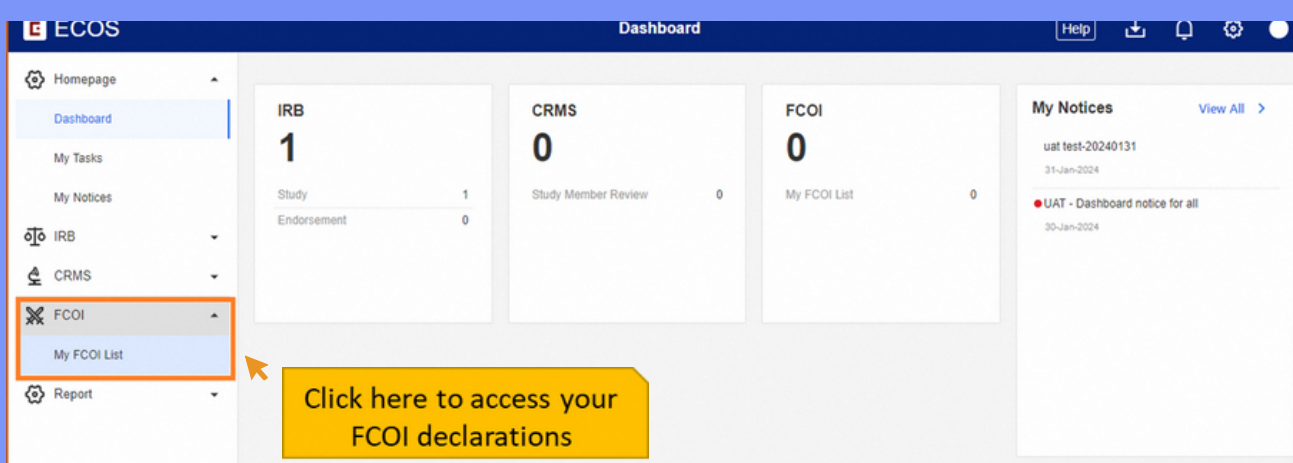

#### Submit Your FCOI Declaration

- Go to [Dashboard] > [FCOI] > [My FCOI List]



- Incomplete user profile, minimum training and FCOI declarations for **other study team members listed in the ECOS CRMS module** (e.g., Collaborators and Study Coordinators) will **not** hinder the submission of new study application or study amendments on ECOS.

- However, PI/ Site PI must ensure that they complete the necessary trainings and declarations in a timely manner.

### The Compliance (DNC & SAE) Module is now LIVE on ECOS!

Moving forward, all Research Institution reviews on:

- Study Deviation/ Non-Compliance Report (DNC) and
- Serious Adverse Event Report (SAE) arising from Human Biomedical Research (HBR) studies will be carried out on ECOS.
